

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Customer/Supplier Information Form REV. 00 of 24/02/2026

We hereby inform you of the processing of your personal data in accordance with applicable data protection legislation. This information is provided pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the European General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter also “ **GDPR** ”) and applicable Italian legislation (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “ **Applicable Legislation** ”).

This information may be subject to changes and/or additions and/or updates, also as a consequence of updates to the applicable personal data protection legislation .

1. DATA CONTROLLER AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER .

The Data Controller is the company **Iacobucci HF Aerospace SpA S.U.** with registered office in Strada Sc Asi 1/S 16-18 - 03013 - Ferentino (FR), CF and VAT number 02316240601 , REA FR-144268, hereinafter also “Data Controller” or simply “Controller”.

2. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS.

The Data Controller collects and processes customer/supplier data and the personal identification and contact details of natural persons acting on behalf of the customer/supplier and/or in their interest (hereinafter, respectively, the “ **Data** ” and the “Data **Subjects** ”). Below we indicate the purposes of the processing and the legal basis that legitimises the processing.

Contractual Purposes : to conclude a contract and fulfill contractual and pre-contractual obligations, such as economic-financial assessment, requesting documentation certifying possession of certain requirements, fulfilling specific requests prior to the conclusion of the contract, ordinary management of the contract, customer support and after-sales assistance. b.	Legal Purposes : to fulfill obligations arising from laws, regulations and/or provisions issued by authorities authorized to do so or by supervisory and control bodies.	Compliance with legal obligations (art. 6, par. 1 letter C, GDPR)
c.	Protection Purpose : to verify that the service complies with the standards offered and to intervene to improve it and to protect your rights in all appropriate judicial and extrajudicial venues.	Legitimate interest (art. 6, par. 1 letter F, GDPR)

What is the legitimate interest that allows the processing?

With regard to the legitimate interest for Protection Purposes, the legitimate interest corresponds to the need to protect the rights and exercise the rights granted to him by law, including the recovery of debts and does not prejudice the freedoms and fundamental rights of the interested party.

3. DATA PROCESSING METHODS.

The Data will be processed using both manual and electronic tools (such as, for example, company IT devices, the Internet, management software, company email, etc.) with methods and tools suitable for ensuring maximum security.

The processing will be based on the principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency, and necessity, and will be done in a way that protects the confidentiality of the data.

The Data is not subject to any automated decision-making process.

4. RETENTION PERIOD.

The Data Controller will retain the Data for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected. In any case, the following retention periods generally apply:

- a) The Data collected for Contractual Purposes are retained for the entire duration of the Contract and for 10 years following its expiration in order to fulfill tax and accounting obligations, as well as for legal protection in the event of disputes arising from the contract itself;
- b) the Data collected for Legal Purposes are retained for a period equal to the duration prescribed by law for each type of Data;
- c) The Data collected for Protection Purposes are retained until the end of the dispute and the expiry of the deadline for appealing the decisions, in any case no later than the expiry of the limitation periods established by law for the exercise of rights.

5. RECIPIENTS OF PERSONAL DATA.

Processing is carried out by the Data Controller's personnel, specifically authorized for their respective roles, as well as by Data Processors specifically identified in writing, within the scope of their respective roles and in accordance with the instructions given by the Data Controller, ensuring the use of appropriate measures to secure the processed data and guarantee its confidentiality. The list of Data Processors is available upon request.

Furthermore, the Data may be communicated to the following categories of recipients:

- a) subjects, entities or authorities to whom, in their capacity as independent data controllers, it is mandatory to communicate the Data by virtue of provisions of law and/or orders of the authorities;
- b) credit institutions, finance companies, credit insurance companies and other credit intermediaries that provide services functional to the purposes described above;
- c) software support companies, cloud and IT service providers;
- d) entities performing supervisory functions or certification bodies, where necessary;
- e) companies or professionals for the judicial or extrajudicial protection of the Data Controller's rights.

6. TRANSFER OF DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES OR INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS .

The collected Data will not be transferred by the Data Controller to countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA) or international organizations.

7. NATURE OF DATA PROVISION.

Providing your Data is necessary to fulfill legal and contractual obligations. Therefore, any refusal to provide it, in whole or in part, may make it impossible for the Data Controller to execute the contract.

8. RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY.

We inform you that, as the data subject, you have the right to withdraw any consent you may have given, as well as to exercise the rights listed below, which you may assert by sending a specific request to the Data Controller at the address above:

- **Right of Access:** Pursuant to Article 15, the interested party has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her is being processed and, if applicable, to obtain a copy of such data. He or she also has the right to obtain access to the personal data concerning him or her and to further information such as the purpose of the processing, the categories of recipients, the data retention period, and the rights to which the data may be subject.
- **Right to rectification:** Pursuant to Article 16, the data subject has the right to obtain the rectification or completion of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her.
- **Right to erasure:** The data subject has the right to obtain the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay, where one of the grounds set forth in Article 17 applies.
- **Right to restriction of processing:** The data subject has the right, in the cases provided for by Article 18 of Regulation 2016/679, to obtain restriction of processing.
- **Right to data portability:** The data subject has the right to receive personal data concerning him or her in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and has the right to transmit such data to another controller without hindrance, pursuant to Article 20 of Regulation 2016/679.
- **Right to object to processing:** The data subject has the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning him or her pursuant to Article 21 of Regulation 2016/679.
- In the case of consent-based processing, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out before the withdrawal.
- **Right to lodge a complaint** with the Data Protection Authority, Piazza Venezia n. 11, 00187, Rome (RM).
